Narrative: While on a _____, P.O. Gregory BYERS, and I (sqd 3340) were in the basement with the Milwaukee Fire Department with a female M.O. _____ suddenly became combative. Numerous attempts to get through to dispatch were unsuccessful. I was attempting to call for a squad with a taser and the wagon with shackles. It took myself, my partner, and (5) Milwaukee Fire Department firefighters to restrain this female who was biting, spitting, kicking, punching, and who also weighed over 300lbs. P.O. BYERS actually had to leave me, go upstairs and outside of the residence to get on the radio to call for help 10-17. This was an extreme safety concern for myself, my partner, and the MFD firefighters. The radio would beep, beep, beep at times

and at other times do nothing at all.
I do not feel as though my safety should not have to be put in jeopardy due to
radio issues.
The time span was 5:16am-6:11am.
